What is our End of Life Care Service?

Specialist support for those caring for people towards the end of their lives.

Who is our Service for?

Our service provides respite for those who are caring for a person living in the Borough of Croydon who is on their GP's Palliative Care Register (usually within the last six months of their life)

How can our Service help?

- We provide person centred support for carers
- We can provide up to 8 hours per week free of charge (funded by Croydon PCT)
- Our service aims to help carers keep their loved ones in their own home for as long as possible
- We provide a fully trained Care Support Worker who can take over the carers role
- We work closely with carers, district nurses and healthcare professionals to ensure that all needs are met

What help do we provide?

- Practical and emotional support
- Regular breaks during the day
- Evening breaks
- Overnight care service
- Personal care
- Administration of medication and other specialist tasks
- Meal preparation & assistance with eating
