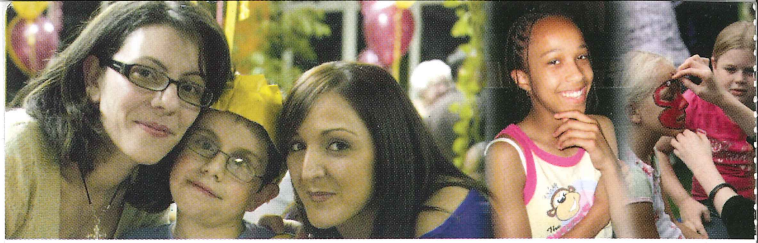

Crossroads Care Croydon offer a Take a break service to parents/guardians of children with special needs, we offer a support service tailored to the individual needs of the child.

This service is specifically designed for parents who do not get a service from Croydon Council but would welcome a break.

Short Break Services

Each child is different and their needs will be different depending on their disability, most of our children suffer from Autism or have a physical disability. Each child will have a thorough assessment by our Children's Coordinator. Our support workers are trained to NVQ level 2 and have had in-house training on Autism.

Saturday Club

Is open for children with disabilities, who have a physical disability and are aged 8 to 18.

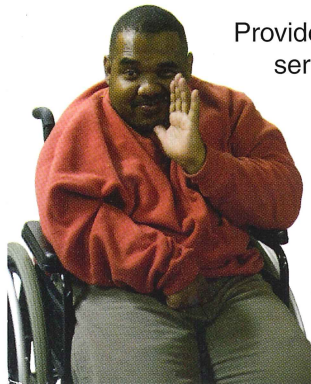
What happens there – We provide structured activities in a supported and stimulating environment. We give the parent/guardian confidence that the child is supported appropriately at the club so that they are able to benefit from the break without worrying about the care being provided in their absence.
